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GLAMOURED is a new one-hour comedy-drama series with the quippy charm of Buffy the Vampire Slayer and the back-stabbing allure of Gossip Girl.

This is a supernatural college story, where saving the world means sacrificing your grade in biology, and family legacies can be, well, powerful. It is also a tale of supernatural creatures exiled to the mortal world, and the alliances and betrayals forged by their struggle to survive.



Sympathetic gobbelins, power hungry humans and lovesick faeries add depth to the creatures that populate this mythology. Characters in this show are not so much looking for a happy ending as searching for ways to forgive and accept themselves.

The Gobbelins are a rebel camp of courtless faeries.




